RECOMMENDATION:

• It is recommended that the Tri-Valley Transportation Council ("TVTC") by motion deny a claim in the matter of Liu v. Herrera, et al. (Estate of Steven Mi)

BACKGROUND:

On February 16, 2016, TVTC received notice of a claim on behalf of Xuan Liu, Austin Mi, and the Estate of Steven Mi against TVTC. On August 14, 2015, Mr. Steven Mi was struck by a vehicle while riding his bicycle along Highway 84 in Alameda County, between the cities of Fremont and Sunol. The claim alleges that Highway 84 was maintained in a dangerous condition. Highway 84 is a California state highway and TVTC does not operate, control, or maintain any portion of it. Thus, staff recommends that TVTC deny this claim.
